Information On Articles

Grace As Justice is looking for articles for its online forum and next issue. As an online anti-trafficking/anti-slavery magazine, articles should address the issue of human trafficking and/or human slavery.

- In particular, the magazine seeks articles that attempt to show the progress of the fight against trafficking and slavery, how individuals can fight, and how people are fighting to end this.
- The magazine has a keen interest to hear from individuals doing what they can to end these atrocities – moms with little time, retired individuals, people writing letters, putting gifts together, raising money, etc.
- Articles that bring light into the darkness.

Additionally, we seek:

- Articles on legal information.
- Articles offering information on the process of trafficking and slavery.
- Articles on psychology and the effects of trauma.
- Articles on business and giving people the ability to leave slavery and trafficking through sustainable means.
- Articles about organizations – big or small.

Articles should be between 500-1,000 words, and the contributor should be prepared to shorten the article if need be, or allow the editor to do so. Articles that have less or more words will be considered, but fewer articles will be accepted at 1,000 words.

Articles should be concentrated for one of three areas:

- Inspire
- Empower
- Educate

Please note that the editor reserves the right to move a story from one to the other if appropriate or necessary.

Articles should be free of improper language, including vulgar language, racial and prejudicial terms. The editor reserves the right to reject or edit any type of article or interview, with the understanding that the central purpose remain intact.

Contributors can expect their contributions to be shared either in the digital magazine, website or both.

At this time, *Grace As Justice* is a volunteer project and cannot offer payment for articles. As time progresses and interest increases, we hope to change this in particular to support those organizations combating human trafficking and slavery.
